Student PowerPanel Login Formula

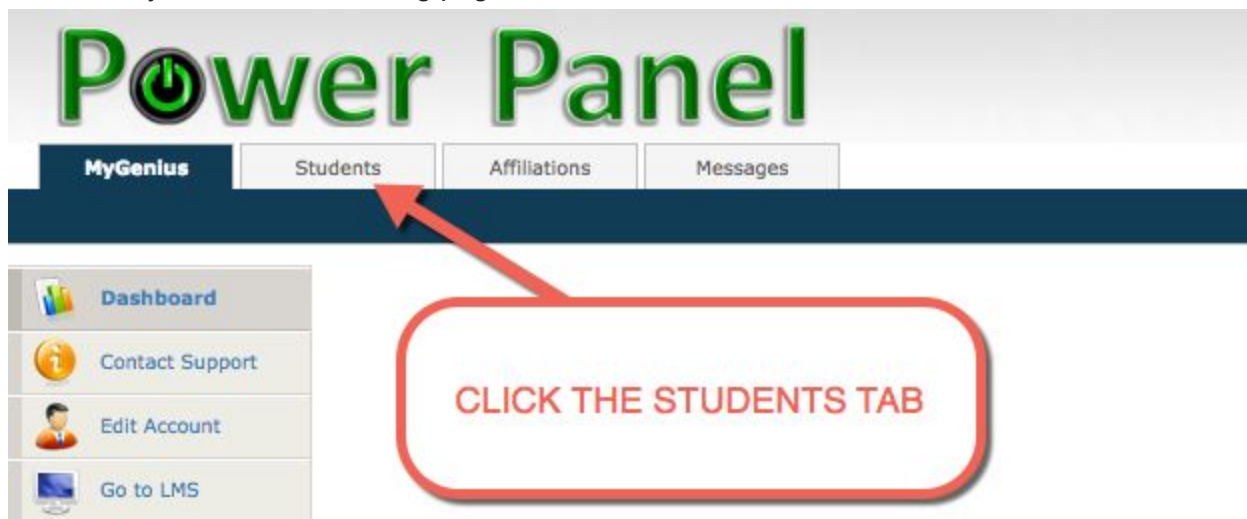
- **Username:** firstinitial.lastname1234 (“1234” represents the last four of the student’s TRIAND number) EXAMPLE: for John Doe = j.doe1234
 - NOTE: The PowerPanel goes by the student’s true first name initial. Keep this in mind If a student goes by another name or middle name!
- **Password:** The initial password formula for all students is: Va!student1234 (“1234” represents the last four of the student’s TRIAND number)

Where can I find a list of all logins?

- Great question! Many facilitators have difficulty getting a list of the TRIAND numbers to help students login. You can get a list from the counselor, but there is a better way.
- Follow the steps below to get all your student's' Login information:

1. Login to the PowerPanel

2. On your facilitator landing page, click the “Students” tab



3. This page will reveal all your Virtual Arkansas students along with the username (login)

TIP: You have several options to organize this information: you can “print page”, you can “Export Results to Excel”, or you can select text, copy, then paste into another document of your choice.

One very successful facilitator copied and pasted the information, made the text larger, then cut the paper into individual strips and placed them in an envelopes. She handed out the envelopes to the respective students on log in day. A little time on the front end will save a lot of time and heartache on the back end!
